

## QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

**Has your VSO received funding from the ASSU Undergraduate Senate Appropriations Committee in prior years? If so, how much and when?**

Aside from Special Fees, no.

**Have you registered your events/organizations with events.stanford.edu? (note: registration is mandatory) (yes/no)**

AASA and its subgroups have tried in good faith to do so. Some have and some have not.

**How large is your officer core?**

Again, AASA core is about 16-20 students. AASA also has 10 subgroups, and each subgroup has its own core governance and membership.

**If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?**

AASA's Special Fees request is increasing this year because we are adding a new subgroup under our umbrella this year: the Asian American Theater Project (AATP). Founded by Stanford alumni David Henry Hwang (author of M. Butterfly), AATP as a pan-Asian performing arts group is a great addition to the AASA family. AASA's other subgroups, especially TCS, KSA, SAAAC, SVSA, and Sanskriti are also growing stronger and are putting on more programming. In addition, some labor and other Event Services costs have increased, something we cannot control.

**Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:**

AASA uses Special Fees to put on events for the greater Stanford community. We invite guest speakers to come talk about social, political, and cultural issues pertinent to our communities. AASA subgroups also organize large cultural events such as TCS Night Market, SVSA Lunar New Year, and Sanskriti Mela Show that involve collaboration with each other as well as with other student groups on campus, both Asian American and others.

**Please describe a few past events organized by our VSO (please limit your response to 50-100 words).**

AASA's two biggest events are Listen to the Silence and Fashion Show. Listen to the Silence is an annual conference on Asian American community issues. Guest speakers from all over the country are invited to give keynote speeches and conduct workshops which are attended by Stanford students. Fashion Show is an annual fundraising benefit that is dedicated to raising awareness about sweatshop labor and to showcasing Asian American fashion designers.

**What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?**

AASA's three largest line items are Event Food, Honoraria, and Equipment Rental, in that order.

Event Food is the largest line-item because there is an enormous popular demand on campus for events that revolve around Asian cultural food, for example TCS Night Market and KSA Korean Culture Night. AASA is mostly composed of ethnic/cultural clubs, and we have found through the years that food is by far the best way to expose Stanford students to Asian Pacific Islander cultures. Also, for many of AASA's events that are not solely about food, refreshments are provided for the speakers and attendees and serve as an incentive for more students to come out and learn about social, political, or cultural issues.

Honoraria is the second largest line-item because AASA invites many speakers to campus for its annual API issues conference, hosts guest speakers for a variety of panels exploring Asian American issues, and invites major API media figures to speak on campus for Asian Images.

Finally, Equipment Rental is the third largest line-item because many of AASA and its subgroups need equipment for the different performance-based programming it puts on, such as concerts and cultural shows. Events necessitate renting facilities, audio and visual equipment, furniture, and a host of other items.

**What is the average attendance at your events?**

Event attendance at AASA's and our subgroups' events ranges from 30-40 at smaller events such as town hall to more than 300 for larger events like the AASA Fashion Show, Sanskriti's Mela Show, and TCS Night Market.

**What is your total membership?**

AASA core ranges from 16-20 students who actively participate in organizing and running events. However, the number of non-core students involved in AASA varies from event to event. During Listen to the Silence and Fashion Show, over 40 students per event participate in organizing the conference and Fashion Show, who are not a part of AASA Core.

**When and why was your VSO established (please limit your response to 50-100 words)?**

The Asian American Students' Association (AASA) was formed in the 1970s to promote consciousness of Asian Pacific Islander (API) cultures, identities and issues as well as to build community among and provide support for API students on campus. AASA supports the ongoing API struggle for justice and equality, affirming the importance of interethnic/interracial diversity while standing in solidarity with all communities of color and the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender movement.

AASA core ranges from 16-20 students who actively participate in organizing and running events. However, the number of non-core students involved in AASA varies from event to event. During Listen to the Silence and Fashion Show, over 40 students per event participate in organizing the conference and Fashion Show, who are not a part of AASA Core.

**What events/programs does your group hold throughout the year for the Stanford Community?**

The following is a partial list of events held by AASA and its subgroups: Listen to the Silence Conference, Asian Images, AASA Fashion Show, SUN Children's Day Festival, NewType all-campus anime screenings, TCS Night Market, SVSA Lunar New Year Celebration and Vietnamese Culture Night, Sanskriti Festival of Lights, Rhythms, Mela, KSA Culture Night, and API Heritage Month events. AASA and its 11 subgroups also put on many regular, weekly and bi-weekly events such as community meetings, town halls, study breaks, film screenings, etc.

**What is the fundamental goal/purpose of your VSO (please limit your response to 50-100 words)?**

The Asian American Students Association (AASA) serves the Asian Pacific Islander (API) community at Stanford through education, organization, service, and action. While serving as a central voice of the API community on campus, AASA strives to develop leadership within its membership so as to provide the opportunities and resources necessary for individuals to pursue their interest and strengthen our community. As such, AASA welcomes community input and involvement. AASA is also the coordinating umbrella organization for 11 API student groups on campus and is dedicated to fostering open communication and cooperation among these different groups.

**What percentage of your total membership is undergraduate? Graduate?**

Our membership consists primarily of undergraduate students. However, AASA subgroups do have a number of graduate students.

**Why are you requesting Special Fees?**

AASA not only puts on many events throughout the year, but also serves as the financial umbrella for 11 subgroups that also produce their own events, independently and in collaboration with AASA. All of AASA's events are open to the entire Stanford student body, and are expensive to finance and organize. Furthermore, AASA co-sponsors events with the Asian American Activities Center (A3C) and other API interest organizations, other communities of color, and other groups to put on interesting and diverse programming.
