Our VSO was established several years ago to fill the need for cultural and secular Jewish programming. It was formed to provide this through educational, cultural, and social programming for both the Jewish community and the greater Stanford community.

The Jewish Students Association does a lot to serve the Undergraduate Community at Stanford; not just the 10% of Stanford's undergraduate population that is Jewish, and focuses its efforts on trying to attract as broad a population as possible. The amount of programming and events demanded by the Undergraduate population requires us to seek Special Fees to support our increasing costs associated with throwing more events for larger audiences. The attendance at our events has grown steadily over the past few years and with our ambitions for next year, we expect this trend to continue.
