**Please describe a few past events organized by our VSO (please limit your response to 50-100 words).**

Cesar Chavez Commemoration- El Centro Chicano and Stanford's Chicano/Latino community annual remembrance of the life and principles of Cesar Chavez. Week-long events including workshops on themes from the life of Cesar Chavez to the present struggles of the labor movement. Our motivational speakers are our highlight--in the past we've had very prominent figures, such as Jesse Jackson and Dolores Huerta.

Raza Day Latino Youth Conference- An all day conference for high school students all over the Bay Area. The conference involves more than 30 forty-five min. workshops put on by a wide range of student organizations. The event also involves a renown keynote speaker. We usually expect around 400 high school students to attend.

**What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?**

Cesar Chavez Commemoration, Honoraria (speakers and performers)- \$5,000

Raza Day, Honoraria (motivational keynote speaker, external workshop leaders, parent session leaders)- \$3,000

Nuestra Graduacion, Honoraria (keynote speaker, music at mass, entertainment at banquet)- \$2,500

**What is the average attendance at your events?**

There is a wide range of attendance, anywhere from 40 at a pre-professional workshop to hundreds in cases like Nuestra Grad, Cesar Chavez Commemoration, Raza Day, and events put on by Ballet Folklorico de Stanford.

**What is the fundamental goal/purpose of your VSO (please limit your response to 50-100 words)?**

MEChA's Special Fees go to support the entire Chicano/Latino community and the many events it hosts annually. We support cultural activities designed not only to celebrate the beauty of the Latino community, but also to educate others at Stanford on the Chicano/Latino experience and to provide orientation and retention programs to ensure academic success for Chicano/Latino students.

**What percentage of your total membership is undergraduate? Graduate?**

Our current membership is comprised entirely of undergraduates.

**Why are you requesting Special Fees?**

The fees requested will fund the many events for the Chicano/Latino community. The Special Fee request will fund large portions of the major Latino community events such as Cesar Chavez Commemoration, La Gran Posada, and Dia De Los Muertos.
