SAIO has no assets other than tents and canopies used for Powwow, approximately \$12,900 in reserves, and no other sources of funding. We have one main ASSU account with acct #6945.

We have hosted Indigenous People's Day, Native American Awareness Week, Mabel Pike as a visiting Native American artist, and our biggest event is Powwow.

The Stanford American Indian Organization is the social, political, educational and cultural hub for the Native American community at Stanford. SAIO is the umbrella organization of American Indians, Alaska Natives and Native Hawaiians at Stanford that addresses the social, political, educational, and cultural issues of the community.

Yes. We applied last year for \$33,810 and the year before for \$32,745. I do not know exactly how much we received, but will have that information shortly.

SAIO works in conjunction with the Powwow committee to bring the annual Stanford Powwow, which attracts over 30,000 world-wide visitors and allows them to affirm and celebrate Native American heritage and culture. SAIO also has programming throughout the year, such as visiting artists, Indigenous Day programming, and the American Indian Film Festival.

What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

Honoraria, Transportation, Event Food. Honoraria is large for Powwow because of the size of the event and the Native Speakers series is large because it is a year long initiative. We request a large amount for transportation expenses because most of our speakers are not from the Bay area.

What is the average attendance at your events?

General SAIO events have approximately 25 people. With 30,000 attending powwow.

What is your total membership?

Approximately 100 members.

What percentage of your total membership is undergraduate?

Graduate?

100% undergraduate.

When and why was your VSO established (please limit your response to 50-100 words)?

Stanford American Indian Organization was established in 1970 by Native American students to address the need for improving the recruitment and retention of Native American students, staff, and faculty, the institutionalizing of culturally relevant curriculum, establishment of a community center and theme house, and the permanent removal of the old Stanford mascot.

Why are you requesting Special Fees?

Special Fees is the sole income for SAIIO and enables us to continue our programming. It allows us to support Native American Students as well as promote cultural awareness in the Stanford Community.
