QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Has your VSO received funding from the ASSU Undergraduate Senate Appropriations Committee in prior years? If so, how much and when? Unsure.

Have you registered your events/organizations with events.stanford.edu? (note: registration is mandatory) (yes/no)

Unsure. However, now aware of policy, SMAP will inform individual clubs to register their organizations and events.

How large is your officer core?

Our officer core consists of a President or two Presidents, a Financial Officer, and a representative from each group (for a total of 13-14 officers).

If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?

SMAP is requesting ~\$1500 more for 2007-08 than 2006-07's \$35,871.86. This increase is due in part to the addition of Stanford Eskrima to SMAP (~\$700 increase). SMAP officers voted to support Eskrima and include it as a member group. Eskrima is a Filipino marital art with emphasis on stick weaponry techniques. SMAP voted to include Eskrima because it represents a unique martial art that adds to the diversity of student groups on campus. The other large increase in money requested of the Special Fee accounts for Wushu's anticipated costs of hosting a collegiate wushu tournament in Maples Pavilion in 2007-08 (main expenses are facilities rental and accommodations for tournament judges). This accounts for ~\$1100 increase in Wushu's requested money, but evens out somewhat in SMAP's over-all budget due to smaller adjustments within all groups.

Have you applied for Special Fees in the past 3 years? If so, please detail the outcome of each attempt.

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{SMAP}}$ has been approved for special fees for each of the past 3 years.

How do you plan to publicize your events/programs to the greater Stanford community? Have you registered with Events at Stanford?

SMAP and its constituent groups will publiczie events and programs through posters and fliers posted throughout campus, email lists, and dorm announcements.

How many members are on your email list?

We do not have an email list for all of SMAP - we disseminate information through each club representative and the individual club lists. Our SMAP email list consists of the officers and representatives from all the subgroups, which comprises about 30 people.

SMAP uses the money from the Special Fee for programming and events such as free self-defense seminars in campus dorms, and martial arts demonstrations. SMAP disperses money from the Special Fee to support a variety of campus martial arts groups. The maintenance of these campus student groups add to the diversity of campus activities and provide a resource for learning the techniques, strategies, histories, and philosophies of different martial arts. Individual clubs also provide a physical recreational and competitive outlet through martial arts for members of the Stanford community.

What events/programs does your group hold throughout the year for the Stanford Community?

Throughout the year SMAP holds self defense workshops in University dorms. These one hour workshops teach students basic physical self defense techniques as well as provide advice for avoiding confrontations in the first place. SMAP also sponsors and staffs a class

through the Athletic Department, Athletics 86: "Introduction to Martial

Arts". This class gives students with no martial arts training an introduction to 3 arts in the course of one quarter, with different styles offered in Fall, Winter and Spring (for a total of 9 styles per year). Our member clubs also put on numerous events of their own, ranging from Wushu performances, to Kenpo's semi-annual 3 hour Women's Self Defense Seminar, to Muay Thai tournaments. JKA organized a martial arts demonstration open to the Stanford community involving all the campus martial arts groups. SMAP plans to continue the organization of this event and broaden its publicity and scope to reach a wider campus audience.

What is the fundamental goal/purpose of your VSO (please limit your response to 50-100 words)?

To foster the martials arts community at Stanford through subsidies toward individual groups as well as to serve the Stanford Community at large through performances, demonstrations, self defense workshops, and tournaments.

What percentage of your total membership is undergraduate? Graduate?

Approximately 60% of our population is Undergraduates, 30% is Grad Students, and the remaining 10% is Stanford Staff, Faculty, Alumni, and local community members.

Please describe a few past events organized by our VSO (please limit your response to 50-100 words).

SMAP events are largely organized by individual groups. For example, Muay Thai recently hosted the "Burnham Brawl" kickboxing tournament in Burnham Pavilion. Stanford Tae-Kwon-Do hosts an annual TKD tournament in Maples Pavilion, drawing hundreds of competitors. In Fall 2006, JKA Shotokan Karate organized a free campus-wide martial arts demonstration with participation from all SMAP groups. After the demonstrations, club representatives were available at information tables to answer questions about their particular martial art.

What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

1. Facilities Rentals (Primarily for the Aikido and Jujitsu clubs) Some of the SMAP member clubs require special practice areas, such as the Stanford Wrestling room, in order to ensure safe practices. The cost of renting these facilities from the University comprises the majority of this line item request.

2. Honoraria for the SMAP director The director oversees all of SMAP's activites, offers advice to the officer core, lobbies the University for student interests, trains instructors for our self defense workshops, oversees and teaches SMAP's "Introduction to Martial Arts" P.E. class, and provides continuity from year to year.

3. SMAP Equipment SMAP groups purchase necessary equipment for training and martial arts demonstrations. SMAP also purchases equipment each year for use in community service programs. This includes mats for our "Introduction to Martial Arts" class, sound equipment for demonstrations and performances, and safety equipment for our self defense workshops.

What is the average attendance at your events?

Our event attendance varies greatly, from hundreds of people at Taekwando meets and all-SMAP dinners to a dozen or so at SMAP sponsored self defense seminars held in dorms.

What is your total membership?

As an umbrella group, our membership is composed of the members of our subgroups. We have 11 subgroups in all, whose combined membership is about 300 individuals.

When and why was your VSO established (please limit your response to 50-100 words)?

An ASSU-sponsored meeting of the martial art student leaders at Stanford formed the basis for SMAP in January 2001. Previously, martial arts at Stanford were supported and offered as PE classes by the Department of Athletics. This relationship officially ended in the summer of 1999, and SMAP arose in response as a student-initiated umbrella organization to help individual groups deal with issues such as practice space, publicity, and funding.
