## QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

**Have you applied for Special Fees in the past 3 years? If so, please detail the outcome of each attempt.**

In the past three years, we have applied for special fees each year and have been granted it all three years.

**If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?**

There is no increase for the budget this year.

**Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:**

It is important for AASA to receive Special Fees because events put on by AASA and the subgroups are important to the quality of life for a large percentage of Stanford Students. These events promote cultural and ethnic diversity and allow students to partake in activities that are important to their own culture. In addition, it allows the campus to be more culturally diverse by having such a wide range of events put on by Stanford Students.

**What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?**

The largest line item requests are honoraria from AASA's Listen to the Silence Conference, technical services for Sanskriti's Rhythm's showcase, and for honoraria for AASA's talent showcase. These items request a lot of money because they are both important to the shows. Without money for honoraria, groups will not be able to request important speakers or performers to come, and without money for technical services, groups will not be able to put on their cultural show. However, most of the money requested is coming from food, honoraria and equipment rental or technical services.

**What is the average attendance at your events?**

The average attendance per events varies because there is such a wide array of events. The largest event, the Listen to the Silence Conference has about 250-300 attendants from across California. Other events such as TCS's night market and SVSA's Lunar new year are large because they are hosted and other subgroups participate. These events usually have about 150-200 people. Cultural shows and performances also have about 100-150 attendants. While most of the events are food based events, that pull in about 50-100 people. Small meetings are also events, so the average number is probably about 50-75 people in attendance for events.

**How do you plan to publicize your events/programs to the greater Stanford community? Have you registered with Events at Stanford?**

All of the large events that groups organize are publicized through e-mails and e-fliers as well as flyering in dorms and bathroom. No event are excluded to specific groups besides perhaps retreats.
