## Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:

We request the Special Fee in order to primarily fund our travel to competitions where we represent Stanford nationally, alongside other college dance teams. On a deeper level, we also help preserve an ancient and traditional folkdance art form, which until recently was not known or performed outside of India. We share this aspect of a culture with the Stanford community as well as our performance attendees from across the country.

## What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

Our most expensive requests are travel fare to New Jersey, Detroit, and accommodations at each of these locations. Whenever possible we try to drive to competitions and stay with family for free - for example, we drive to Garba With Attitude (Long Beach, CA) and stay for free with a teammate's family - in order to reduce costs. Still, because our goal is to continue to represent Stanford nationally, we must consider costs of traveling to and staying at other competitions across the country.

We regularly apply for funding from ASSU Undergrad Senate as well as The Stanford Fund, however the costs of airfare are not covered entirely by this funding, which we use primarily to fund costumes and stage props (airfare is often paid for out of team member dues). Thus, we would like to request Special Fees so that our team members may still enjoy competing as a team and representing Stanford without undergoing financial strain.
