Have you applied for Special Fees in the past 3 years? If so, please detail the outcome of each attempt.

Yes, AASA has applied each of the last three years. In the past three years, we have passed each time.

If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?

Yes, technical services and space rental costs at places like Cubberley & Dink have increased this year. Also, Kresge and Manz are no longer options. It has required many of our groups to have to move locations which then limit our ability to utilize previously free services like SCN in locations like Cubb Aud.

Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:

AASA uses Special Fees to put on events for the greater Stanford community. We invite guest speakers to come talk about social, political, and cultural issues pertinent to our communities. AASA subgroups also organize large cultural events such as TCS Night Market, SVSA Lunar New Year, and Sanskriti Mela Show that involve collaboration with each other as well as with other student groups on campus, both Asian American and others.

What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

Event Food -- Many of our subgroups are culturally based and celebrate various holidays. There are a diverse array of holidays celebrated by our community. Many of them center around food. There are also numerous events and conferences held as meal time events requiring much food.

Technical Services -- Our community hosts on minimum four culture shows and a variety of other performances requiring technical services provided only by Stanford ABM. A majority of the equipment we need and use also comes from ABM for our performers, speakers and cosponsored events.

Honorarium -- Because the community is so large, there are many, many different kinds of guests invited to speak on various topics. In order to fully understand the multiplicities of the community, multiple speakers are normally engaged. Also, the topics and areas of the community they arrive from are vastly arrayed.

AASA and its 11 subgroups also put on many regular, weekly and bi-weekly events such as community meetings, town halls, study breaks, film screenings, etc.

Why are you requesting Special Fees?

AASA not only puts on many events throughout the year, but also serves as the financial umbrella for 11 subgroups that also produce their own events, independently and in collaboration with AASA. All of AASA's events are open to the entire Stanford student body, and are expensive to finance and organize. Furthermore, AASA co-sponsors events with the Asian American Activities Center (A3C) and other API interest organizations, other communities of color, and other groups to put on interesting and diverse programming.
