## Have you applied for Special Fees in the past 3 years? If so, please detail the outcome of each attempt.

We have applied for special fees the past three years. Each year we received practically everything we applied for with the exception of a few items that are not approved by the ASSU guidelines.

#### If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?

We did apply for Special Fees last year. There is a small increase to reflect a change in our spending habits ( i.e more towards educational literature, less for gas) and also to demonstrate the increasing cost of rental cars.

## Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:

Barrio Assistance provides tutoring and mentoring for elementary school and middle school students from East Palo Alto and Menlo Park. The program provides a forum for Stanford students to interact with neighboring outside communities in a productive and mutually beneficial way. Barrio Assistance also provides food and hosts periodic events for students at large on the Stanford campus.

## What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

Food, car rentals, and educational literature are our largest line items requests. These line items correspond to services which Barrio Assistance provides weekly to its students and tutors. Food is provided at all events both for tutors, Centro Staff, and any other Stanford students at El Centro Chicano. Most of our students are from East Palo Alto and would not be able to attend the program without transportation from their homes. Car rentals go toward funding weekly transportation of all tutees to and from Stanford. Lastly are striving to increase our workbooks and get the same workbooks that the schools are using so that when the students come they can continue to work with materials they will encounter at school. These workbooks are expensive and require more funding than normal.

### What is the average attendance at your events?

Approximately 25-35 tutors are present at each of our tutoring sessions on Fridays and Saturdays, along with a comparable number of students, six coordinators, and Centro staff.

# How do you plan to publicize your events/programs to the greater Stanford community? Have you registered with Events at Stanford?

Each week El Centro Chicano sends a weekly schedule for events happening at Centro. We are mentioned weekly and the events are open to the campus in general. Also we will re-register with Events at Stanford.
