Yes -- we were successful each time.

**If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?**

In absolute terms, yes. In inflation-adjusted terms, no. We're just maintaining our purchasing power!

**Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:**

Our services include cultural, religious, and social programming aimed at the Jewish and broader Stanford community.

**What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?**

The three largest are:

- 1. Honorarium -- we host a number of large scale speaker events that attract a very significant attendance (more than enough to justify the cost).
- 2. Food -- much of our community and cultural programming centers around food -- food plays a central role in Jewish culture and religious observance and will be present at everything for Shabbat Dinners to Seders.
- 3. Equipment rental -- we need a basic set of equipment for three different events each year in Hillel -- our Klezmer Dance Party, Open Mic Night, and the JSA Comedy Night. The final rental is for our very popular yearly Laser Tag event.

**What is the average attendance at your events?**

Attendance varies very much upon the content and purpose of the event. Our large speaker events attract as many as 600 people. Our Shabbat Dinners attract around 75. Cooking classes are generally limited to around 20.

**How do you plan to publicize your events/programs to the greater Stanford community? Have you registered with Events at Stanford?**

Yes -- we publicize via extensive email and Facebook campaigns. We also use fliers. Finally, we rely upon word of mouth, texting, phone calls, etc to get people to our events.
