## **QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

# Have you applied for Special Fees in the past 3 years? If so, please detail the outcome of each attempt.

Yes, we were approved with modifications, then petitioned and was elected by the student body to the full amount. SIAS had the same financial officer for the last 3 years and I can contact him for more details.

#### If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?

Yes. We've made a push for expansion of the Model UN team this year, bringing an average of 5 more delegates to each conference. For example, whereas we've usually taken 18 - 20 delegates to the Yale conference in the past, we took 25 this past fall. By building on this year's expansion, Stanford is moving towards becoming on par with other top teams in the country (e.g. Yale, Harvard) with an average of 20 - 25 delegates at each competition. Part of the expansion is possible because of our ability to provide for travel, accomodations and registration expenses, allowing the delegates to travel for free. Furthermore, the high school conference is also expanding aggressively, with a projected attendance of 700, a 17% increase from last year. We're also expecting the conference to grow by 100 delegates each year for the next few years. Expansion means increased Marguerite rental fees, ABM janitorial fees, office supplies costs, more room, extra food for advisors and delegates.

### Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:

As a group, we seek to provide the Stanford Community with high quality programming that is geared towards international relations. This includes opportunities for students to get involved in serious foreign affairs competitions by joining Stanford's Model UN team. This includes bringing speakers to campus that address issues of international importance (nuclear proliferation, for example). This includes exposing to Model UN, and in this way to international relations, about 700 high school students from around the world (with many from the bay area) through our annual Model UN Conference (SMUNC). Organizing and running the conference is also a very valuable learning experience for Stanford undergraduates.

# What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

Our 3 largest items are, in order, Travel Fares, Accomodations and Registration Expenses for the UChicago conference. This is one of the nation's top conferences and certainly the highest-quality conference that we've attended. It is important for Stanford, as a nationally competitive team, to ensure that its members can afford to attend the Chicago conference in strength. Charging team members would discriminate against economically disadvantaged students.

## What is the average attendance at your events?

For the Model UN team, we bring 15 - 25 students to each conference. We go to 4, 5 conferences/year.

Our high school conference, SMUNC, is expected to have up to 700 delegates in attendance, supported by 60 - 70 undergraduates as

Our other events vary from 20 - 100, depending on the kind of events (e.g. policy lunch would have about 10 - 15, whereas the international development conference is expecting 50 - 100).

# How do you plan to publicize your events/programs to the greater Stanford community? Have you registered with Events at Stanford?

We will flyer campus and send emails to all mailing lists that SIAS members have access to. SMUNC will be registered with Events at Stanford. Recruitment for SMUNC staff has already begun for the November conference.

# What events/programs does your group hold throughout the year for the Stanford Community?

We hold an average of 3 events per quarter where we bring distinguished scholars to speak on issues of international relations and organize related events. For example, we're hosting a film screening, a policy lunch and co-sponsoring a conference on international development. We host Stanford's annual high school Model UN conference (SMUNC). Finally, we run Stanford Model UN Team which represents Stanford at 4-5 conferences each year.

## Why are you requesting Special Fees?

We are requesting Special fees because we are committed to bring to the Stanford Community high quality events focused on international relations. First, we put on a high quality Stanford Model UN Conference (SMUNC) for high schoolers every year takes a lot of money. From room reservation fees, to printer supplies, to postcards, to food, and to the delegate social, we need the ability to fund that. Second, our community service and speaker's series require gas money, honoraria, room rental fees, etc. Third, we run Stanford's Model UN team, which by virtue of being a traveling team takes significant money to maintain. The best Model UN conferences are on the east coast and we have to pay for 20+ people's flights, accomodations, registration fees, and so forth.
