 To provide instructional and recreational opportunities to Stanford undergraduate and graduate student-athletes in a player-oriented setting unique to the Club Sports program;

 To promote student-run athletic teams by emphasizing student leadership in training, competition, team management, and program direction;

 To encourage athletes at all levels, from recreational to elite, by maintaining a fun, athlete-focused environment and by recognizing individual and team achievement;

 To provide, where practical and appropriate, financial and logistical assistance to teams and athletes in advancing their level of training and competition;

5) To bring together students, faculty, and staff from diverse backgrounds to share their enthusiasm for a broad array of athletic activities.

We have been successfully funded for the past three years for both joint and undergraduate Special Fees.

If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?

There is a slight (less than 2.5%) increase in our joint special fees request. This increase reflects increasing costs, particularly for coaching and travel expenses, at the rate of inflation. We are also losing an outside funding source (the President's Fund) that has assisted teams with travel costs and member financial aid in the past three years.

Each club has its own publicity methods which include activity fairs, flyering, Orientation information sessions, etc.

Reserves: \$65106.12; Assets excluding reserves: \$32531. Non-reserve assets will be distributed to teams during spring quarter as expenses arise (in particular, as teams qualify for post-season events such as Regional and National Championships, current assets will be used to assist with travel, lodging, registration, and special equipment/uniform needs). All funds are in ASSU accounts. Other funding sources vary by team and include Stanford Fund letter-writing, work hours at Athletic Department events, revenue from team tournaments and functions, and donations from parents and alumni.

What events/programs does your group hold throughout the year for the Stanford Community?

Teams sponsor a range of events and competitions, most of which are open to spectators in the community. Examples include equestrian shows, cycling races, martial arts tournaments, and rugby games on campus. Teams also hold regular practices and occasional social events for members. Membership is open to all enrolled Stanford students.

What percentage of your beneficiaries are (explain basis or how this was determined) graduates and undergraduates? Based on rosters submitted by teams each guarter, the overall

population of Club Sports students is approximately 25% Graduate and 75% Undergraduate students. Special Fees benefit each group member equally regardless of grad/undergrad status.

What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

Our largest line items are Honoraria, Facility Rental, and Airfare (Travel Fares). Honoraria are used to pay team coaches - although some teams are able to find volunteer coaches, many compete at a high level and wish to hire both full and part-time professional coaches. Facility Rental is a large expense for teams such as Equestrian and Horse Polo, which rent stable space, and Ice Hockey, a sport that does not have facilities available on campus. Airfare is a significant component of expenses for all teams traveling to regional and national tournaments and has been increasing rapidly in recent years, while funding from other sources has declined. Registration expenses are our fourth-largest line item - these represent league and conference dues as well as tournament registration fees.

What is the average attendance at your events?

Attendance varies across clubs and events (practices, team socials, races/tournaments, etc). The average membership of a Club Sports team is approximately 45 students, with an average split of about 25% grad and 75% undergrad students.

Why are you requesting Special Fees?

We are requesting Special Fees in order to provide the necessary funding to each of our sports, allowing them to compete nationally and providing a forum for the existence of the club sports program.
