### **QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

## Have you applied for Special Fees in the past 3 years? If so, please detail the outcome of each attempt.

Yes. Last year and the years before that we received all the Special Fees funding we requested.

### If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?

Yes, we have requested roughly 3,500 more because we have overspent already on our CoHo series in order to bring better artists, and we requested more postage because we use it more than we normally budget for. Also we requested more in Honoraria because this line item allows us the most flexibility in allowing us to bring more or more prominent artists to campus.

#### Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:

We present a diversity of contemporary entertainment events in both size and content which appeals to students. We have a concert producing system which provides hands on educational opportunities for students to learn how to produce a variety of events. We act as a central resource for all other student organizations in bringing contemporary acts to campus.

## What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

The three largest line item requests are honoraria, programming expenses and co-sponsorships. Honoraria is the largest because we have to spend a great deal on bands and performers that are expected to attract the student body, especially for our spring shows and other medium shows like Black/FutureFest and SnowChella type concerts. Co-sponsorships allow SCN is be a central resource in helping other student groups provide diversity in entertainment. Programming and Technical services will cover some logistical issues that we have deemed important this year such as janitorial services, hospitality, accomodations, staging and tent rental.

#### What is the average attendance at your events?

Our regular house show draw approximately close to the capacity depending on the venue (Synergy, Block Party, EBF, Chi Theta Chi, Kappa Sigma). We expect 1000-2000 attendees of FutureFest/BlackFest. We had about 500 attendees of SnowChella and we expect 500 at our 4/19 show. Our weekly CoHo series draws 30-50 people each week.

# How do you plan to publicize your events/programs to the greater Stanford community? Have you registered with Events at Stanford?

Yes. We plan to publicize with flyers, facebook ads, word of mouth, mass emails, buttons, stickers and any other manner than our publicity team comes up with.

1) Current total assets are \$170,850.50. This includes the money in our reserves, ASSU accounts and special fees. 2) Reserves: \$68,051.77. SCN is unique because we need a large amount of reserves in order to bring larger artists to campus (ie for Spring Show) and also to anticipate unexpected costs that we may incur for a particular concert which can be particularly hefty. Please see Nanci Howe for more details on our & amp;quot;unexpected cost& amp;quot; policy. 3) Our 7062 Account has a balance of \$180,259.20.

### What events/programs does your group hold throughout the year for the Stanford Community?

SCN has a weekly concert series every Thursday in the CoHo throughout the entire school year excluding summer quarter. These shows feature student, local or small signed artists and usually a student opener. We generally have one-three medium shows in either White Plaza stage or one of the houses on campus such as Kappa Sigma, EBF, etc. We also cosponsor many group events such as Blackfest, FutureFest, and SnowChella in addition to providing sound techs and equipment for an Dance Marathon, Art Affair, Mixed Company, SAID, Hawaiian Club Luau, etc. In addition, we help bring musicians on campus together to form bands and other musical groups. We typically hold a Big Game show of medium size and have now undertaken the responsibility of throwing a many more medium shows because a show in Frost Amphitheater takes two-year budgeting.

#### Why are you requesting Special Fees?

The Stanford Concert Network is dependent on funding from Special Fees in order to afford to produce the number and variety of shows and concerts on the Stanford campus that the undergraduate student body has come to expect of our organziation over the years. Since we provide significantly reduced ticket prices and free tickets to students on all shows, ticket revenues are not nearly sufficient to cover the expense of production and payment to our featured artists. Special Fees funding is necessary to cover the difference between our revenues and expenses.
