Yes, We received the Special Fee in 2006-7. We removed ourselves from the ballot in 2007-8.

If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why? n/a

Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:

SPOON is Stanford's gateway organization to understanding hunger issues and promoting hunger awareness. The group's mission is three-fold: to salvage unused dining hall food and donate it to local food banks; to sponsor breakfast cooks in which students cook and serve breakfast for the homeless; and to promote hunger awareness through outreaches, hunger banquets, speakers, and concerts.

What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

1) Dan Glickman speaking event. We would like to host former USDA Secretary Dan Glickman for an evening. Cosposnsoring this event with Ethics in Society, the ASSU Speakers Bureau, and SIG, we hope to get an audience of approximately 350 - nearly filling Cubberly Auditorium. Glickman is particularly relevant to our group as he blends

government policy, non-profit activism, and hunger. In fact, as USDA Secretary - he took large steps to curb hunger and food insecurity in the US.

2) Tins - we need tins to compete food salvaging operations3) New Fridge(s): We are rapidly expanding our operations. We will likely be needing to purchase a small, new freezer and replace our aging freezer - it is over 10 years old.

What is the average attendance at your events?

We have a number of different types of events. For our co-sponsored events, we've had hundreds attend the Food Stamps Challenge, the Hunger and Homelessness Awareness Week, and an event with USDA Deputy Sec. Kathleen Merrigan. We will be having approximately 30 students at a series of lunches concerning poverty and homelessness.

How do you plan to publicize your events/programs to the greater Stanford community? Have you registered with Events at Stanford?

No - we have not registered with Events - they require a dedicated person to post events. Unfortunately, our leadership has been quite fluid this year - this will be a goal in the upcoming year. We primarily publicize through email lists, especially Service4all
