Yes. We have only a very slight \$150 increase for Event food. We have been receiving many more people at our post-concert receptions and have therefore needed to buy more food than in the past.

We provide concerts for the Stanford community on a regular basis (at least 4 times a year).

What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

Facilities rental (the Music Department doesn't wholly cover the cost of renting Dinkelspiel Auditorium for rehearsals and performances) 3. Renting instruments from the Music Department (eg. percussion instruments, Baritone saxophone, etc).

What is the average attendance at your events?

At each of our concerts, we usually get about 150-200 people attending.

We are requesting Special Fees to be able to continue rehearsing and performing wind ensemble music. We play five concerts a year, one each quarter, with a special collaborative concert with the orchestra for Halloween. Our fifth concert is a concert exchange with the Wind Ensemble at CSU Hayward which takes place either at the Stanford or the Hayward campus (it alternates year to year). Additionally, we aim to increase the variety of our concerts by hiring well known guest soloists to perform with the group.
