First and foremost, our group represents Stanford at Model United Nations Conferences at various colleges. All major prestigious colleges maintain Model UN teams that compete several times annually, and certainly part of each school's reputation depends on the success of its competitive teams, both academic and athletic. Our team has consistently performed highly in these conferences, often placing in the top three schools in the country. In addition, our conference brings high school students to Stanford, providing both a service to surrounding schools and giving Stanford students a chance to participate in a fun mock international conference. SIAS also holds campus events that hope to further the understanding and knowledge of international affairs here at Stanford.

What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

The largest item requests are for travel, accommodations and registration fees for conferences.

What is the average attendance at your events?

~500 delegates per conference

How do you plan to publicize your events/programs to the greater Stanford community? Have you registered with Events at Stanford?

We register the majority of events with Events at Stanford and we usually flyer around campus and send out emails to publicize our events. We also recruit heavily for the Model UN team and the Model UN Conference at the beginning of each academic year.
