Yes, we have been approved all three years.

#### If you applied for Special Fees last year, is there an increase in the amount you're seeking this year? If so, why?

There is an increase in the amount we are requesting. Last year, we tried to minimize our budget because we knew Special Fees was in jeopardy of being too large across all student groups. We looked for line-items that we could trim, and we did. However, we ran into a few instances in which we were forced to move funds from our reserves to cover a cost. For 2011-2012, we are increasing our request slightly, but please not that the amount (\$15,000) is still far less than the group has requested in the past (up to \$22,000).

## Please define the services provided by your group with the Special Fee, as per the ASSU Constitution:

The Stanford Jazz Orchestra uses the Special Fee to help pay for the guest artists we bring the perform with us at our quarterly concerts. The presence of guest artists significantly increases attendance and allows Stanford students to hear world-renowned musicians for a very low cost.

## What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?

Honoraria Fees make up 90 percent of our budget. We use this money to pay our guest artists for their time and services.

#### What is the average attendance at your events?

We are generally able to fill Dinkelspiel Auditorium for all of our indoor concerts.

We have registered with events at Stanford. We publicize our events through e-mail, flyers, the artsquide and ISIS.

Currently, we have about \$17k in assets, split between honoraria fees, our discretionary account and equipment maintenance. All but the discretionary account were funded by special fees. The only other source of revenue we have is CD sales, which are deposited into the discretionary account. Our reserve is \$9,036.18.

## What events/programs does your group hold throughout the year for the Stanford Community?

Every quarter, the Stanford Jazz Orchestra performs a concert that is open to everyone to attend. These concerts are both educational and enjoyable for the students that attend. For each quarterly concert, we invite a guest artist to play with us, a standard thing for all college groups to do. They are always world-class jazz musicians, and students get to see them for far less money than they would at any other venue. Recent examples of artists include Louis Bellson, John Faddis and Carl Allen. Each is a world leader in the jazz community and history.

#### Why are you requesting Special Fees?

We are asking for Special Fees because the Stanford Jazz Orchestra runs a rather large budget. The cost of our guest musicians is very high compared to our concert revenue. Yet these guest artists are necessary for the success of the group, as they draw enough people to see the concert, as well as help educate members of the group about music. Students get to see the concerts for free, which they likely would not be able to do at other venues, such as jazz clubs.
